


Endling: Stories from the End of the World is an ongoing multimedia science fiction narrative. The first part of the work chronicles the events that led to the extinction of all species and it introduces the only survivor: Mnemosyne Unit-01, a mech hypercreature developed by humans to contain the DNA of all living organisms-like a contemporary Noah's ark. The hypercreature is named for the Greek goddess Mnemosyne, who is the goddess of memory and daughter of Gaia, who represents the Earth. Mnemosyne Unit-01 absolute priority is survival, as if it's in a permanent state of war so everything is reduced. Even life itself is reduced to data.





The narrative begins with the website of a fictional operating system (Utopia-2130). Once downloaded, the narrative continues within the application, which, when completed, leads the player on to a website containing a 3D model of the hypercreature. So the audience will navigate websites, applications, video games, 3D models, and video in order to understand the full story of this post-apocalyptic hypercreature, Mnemosyne Unit-01. This construction formalizes the way that we access data today: through multiple websites, apps, and different streams of data to create a complex but coherent narrative.
